Resolution on Perrysburg, voted on and passed by the Conservation Committee
May 17 2005:

Whereas: The J.N. Adam Hospital at Perrysburg has closed and its buildings and 660 acres of scenic rural land have become available.

Whereas: This park-like natural setting with its commanding view of Lake Erie contains 450 acres of mature woodland protecting the watershed of the Village of Perrysburg and providing habitat for a wide diversity of flora and fauna.

Whereas: We recognize the need to preserve certain untrammelled tracts of natural landscape for the purposes of education, recreation and biodiversity.

Whereas: The Perrysburg Hospital buildings, designed by noted architect John Hopper Coxhead, are of historic significance to the many patients and staff who worked there as well as to students of architecture.

Resolved: We will work for the preservation of the Perrysburg forest in its natural state and the preservation and re use of its historic buildings. To those ends, we will cooperate with the Buffalo Common Council and the Friends of J.N. Adam.
